

DESERT COURSE LOCAL RULES

- All Desert Areas are played as waste bunkers.
- Golfers are allowed to ground their clubs in the sand, even take divots on practice swings.
- Golfers may remove loose impediments such as twigs, leaves, loose soil or stones.
- In the desert area, a ball may be lifted and dropped without penalty, within one club length from the nearest point of relief but not nearer the hole
- 1. Footprints
- 2. Divots
- 3. Washed away areas (usually caused by heavy downpour)
- A ball in the desert area can be deemed unplayable, with a one stroke penalty, you may drop the ball within two club lengths of the point at which the ball last crossed the grass line into the desert.
- Please note that the right hand side of Desert #3 and #5 are played as sand bunkers NOT desert areas.
